OC Transpo Community Passes for ODSP participants now sold at Ottawa Public Library branches

Ottawa –OC Transpo and the Ottawa Public Library have teamed up to make it easier for our customers to get their Community Pass each month.

Eight Ottawa Public Library (OPL) branches across the City will be selling the passes, starting in June. This nearly doubles the number of places transit users can buy Community Passes, which are discounted transit passes available to people participating in the Ontario Disability Support Program. It also means speedier service that's closer to home and closer to the services of the OPL.

Remember to bring your OC Transpo photo identification card when purchasing your Community Pass.

Community Pass holders can take advantage of their visit and benefit from the free services at the OPL. In fact, library cards are free for all Ottawa residents. Once you have a card, you can borrow books, movies, music and museum admission passes, as well as access public computers — for free.

The Community Pass continues to be available at OC Transpo Sales Centres: Rideau Centre, St. Laurent Transitway Station, Place d'Orléans Transitway Station and Lincoln Fields Transitway Station.

The Community Pass can also be purchased at City of Ottawa Client Service Centres: City Hall, Terry Fox Drive in Kanata, Ben Franklin Place in Nepean and Centrum Blvd. in Orléans and at Royal Ottawa Mental Health Centre.
