OC Transpo reminds users U-Pass is not for sale

Ottawa – The U-Pass pilot project provides university students unlimited access to transit from September 2010 until April 2011.

The U-Pass is a mandatory program that was put in place as result of requests made by the student bodies of the universities of Carleton and Ottawa. Referendums at these schools confirmed popular support for these heavily discounted passes.

OC Transpo reminds U-Pass holders that passes are not transferable and cannot be sold to others. Doing so is illegal.

If caught, you could face heavy fine and have your pass confiscated.

Full terms of use are on the back of the pass. The Transit by-law also clearly states that only authorized vendors are allowed to sell OC Transpo passes and tickets.
