City advises public of certain downtown road closures this weekend

Ottawa – Slater Street will be closed between Lyon Street and Kent Street this weekend and next to allow for construction.

The closure begins on Friday, December 10 at 9 p.m. and will continue until Sunday, December 12, at 9 p.m.

The same stretch of roadway will also be closed from Friday, December 17 starting at 9 p.m. continuing through Sunday, December 19 at 9 p.m.

During both weekends, all eastbound traffic, including OC Transpo buses on the Transitway, will be routed south onto Lyon Street, east onto Laurier Avenue, and north onto Kent Street before returning to Slater Street.

OC Transpo passengers please note that the **eastbound Kent Transitway Station** will not operate during this time, and alternate Transitway stations along Slater Street, including Bay, Bank and Metcalfe, should be used for **eastbound passengers only**. Additional information will be posted at Kent Street Station to assist passengers.

Service at the westbound Kent Transitway Station on Albert Street will continue as scheduled.

Please note that weather conditions could postpone work and detours on short notice. For the latest information on OC Transpo, call 613-741-4390 or visit octranspo.com.

In addition, O'Connor Street between Slater Street and Laurier Avenue will be closed this weekend only to allow for construction.

The closure will begin on Friday, December 10 at 7 p.m. and will continue until Monday, December 13 at 6 a.m.
