## Transit to Algonquin College



Algonquin College is conveniently located across from Baseline Transitway Station and served by many bus routes. Whether you live on campus or commute, transit service is fast, frequent and economical.

- Routes **94** and **95** are your high frequency Transitway service at Baseline Station. The 95 operates 24 hours a day and both routes run along a rapid transit corridor, serving downtown, Nepean South, Ottawa East, Orléans and VIA Rail Train Station.

- Route **86B** provides a direct link from the Elmvale area via downtown and travels along Fisher and Meadowlands.
- Route **87** provides a link to Carlingwood and travels via the Transitway and downtown to Ottawa South and Riverside Drive.
- Route **111** serves Billings Bridge and Carleton University, and travels via Meadowlands, Heron and Bronson.
- Route **118** travels along Baseline Road and serves the campus seven days a week from Kanata and Bells Corners in the west, and Billings Bridge and Hurdman Station in the east.
- Additional service is provided by local Routes **156, 172** and **178**, and peak period Routes **157** and **174**.
- **Connexion 400** is your direct service to events at Scotiabank Place. From Baseline Station, take routes **402** or **406**. Other 400 routes operate from different parts of the city.

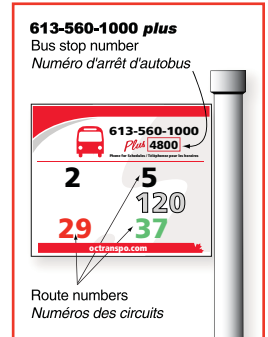
## Bike & Ride, Rack & Roll or Park & Ride

You can ride your bike to a Transitway Station, then lock it up and hop on a bus for a relaxing ride. Or, take your bike with you on routes 94, 95 and 118 which have buses equipped with bike racks. *Got a car?* Use one of our conveniently located Park & Ride lots and let us worry about the traffic.

## Schedules

**Black** routes generally run all day, seven days a week. **Red** and **green** routes run during peak periods on weekdays only, and green routes require a premium fare.

Route timetables and schedules for all bus stops are posted on the web at [octranspo.com](http://octranspo.com). Schedules are posted in all transit stations and at many bus stops. Or, call 613-560-1000 *plus* the 4-digit number on your bus stop flag. For Baseline Station, call **613-560-1000 plus 3017**. Call 613-741-4390 seven days a week for information on routes, trip planning and to receive free maps and timetables.



## Fares – Save with a Student Pass

Pay with cash (exact change), tickets or pass, but save the most with a discounted student pass for **full-time** students living in Ontario. Correct fares are displayed in the bus windshield.

Buy bus tickets and monthly passes on campus, at OC Transpo Sales Centres and at over 350 vendors in the City. Semester passes can be bought on campus, at OC Transpo Sales Centres and at City of Ottawa Client Service Centres. Annual passes can only be purchased at OC Transpo Sales Centres. A low-cost Pass Protection Plan for lost or stolen annual passes is available at the time of purchase.

## Semester passes available for fall, winter and summer!

You'll need an OC Transpo photo ID (\$6.25) to go with your pass. Get your picture taken on campus **until the end of September**. Or, go to an OC Transpo Sales and Information Centre with a photo ID, proof of age, and your official timetable or a letter from the Registrar that shows full-time status. Photo IDs will also be sold at City Hall and the City of Ottawa Client Service Centre in Kanata, Mondays through Fridays from August 24 to September 9 (excl. Sept. 5) and September 19 to 30, between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
