## Transit to Carleton University

Take the **O-Train** to campus this fall. Ride in comfort aboard the modern Light Rail Bombardier Talent Train. The O-Train runs between Greenboro Station in the south and Bayview Station in the north, with a handy stop right in the heart of campus. Service runs seven days a week and every 15 minutes in most time periods. Use your transit pass or buy a \$2.85 O-Train ticket. Please remember — always use the pedestrian tunnel to cross the tracks.



If the train is not along your route, then the bus is still a fast, easy and economical way of getting to campus.

- Routes **4** and **7** operate on campus all day, seven days a week. Catch route 4 downtown on Rideau or Queen Streets, or transfer to Route 4 at Hurdman or Billings Bridge Stations. Catch route 7 downtown on Bank or Rideau Streets.
- Route **111** serves the campus Monday to Friday and connects with Algonquin College. Catch the bus at Baseline Station, Billings Bridge or along Meadowlands.

## Accessible Transit

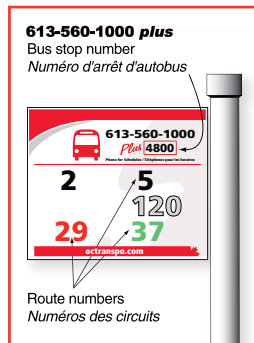
## Bike & Ride, Rack & Roll or Park & Ride

You can ride your bike, then lock it up and hop on a bus for a relaxing ride downtown. Or, take your bike with you on the O-Train (use door with green bike symbol). *Got a car?* Use one of our conveniently located Park & Ride lots and let us worry about the traffic.

## Schedules

**Black** routes generally run all day, seven days a week. **Red** and **green** routes run during peak periods on weekdays only, and green routes require a premium fare.

Route timetables and schedules for all bus stops are posted on the web at [octranspo.com](http://octranspo.com). Schedules are also posted in all transit stations and at many bus stops. Or, call 613-560-1000 plus the 4-digit number on your bus stop flag.

## Fares

### U-Pass Starts September 1

This fall, full-time students will enjoy the convenience of the Universal transit pass. Students will have the freedom of getting around without worrying about exact fare, or buying bus tickets or the next month's pass.



The U-Pass cost, which is included in your student fees, is \$290 for the fall and winter semesters.

### Benefits of the U-Pass

- ✓ Significant savings compared to a regular monthly or semester pass — \$310 and \$220 respectively.
- ✓ Unlimited travel.
- ✓ Helps support a sustainable community.

### What you need to know about using the U-Pass

- Valid September 1, 2011 to April 30, 2012.
- Valid as full fare on OC Transpo regular, express and rural express routes, and the O-Train.
- Valid on Para Transpo, although rural areas require a zone top-up.
- Valid on STO service with a top-up on express and interzone routes. If you board an STO route outside Gatineau's downtown core before 9 a.m., you must also have an Ontario Residency card. For more information, contact STO at 819-770-3242 or [sto.ca](http://sto.ca).
- For full-time students only, including graduate students.

### How to get your U-Pass

Your U-Pass will be available on campus. Visit your campus web site for locations, dates and times.

Part-time students can pay with cash (exact change) or tickets. The correct fare is displayed in the bus windshield. Buy bus tickets, at OC Transpo Sales Centres and at over 350 vendors in the city. Purchase an O-Train ticket from the vending machine at the station just before you travel.

### Cash and Ticket Fares

<b>Regular</b> .....	\$.325 or two \$1.30 tickets
<b>Express</b> .....	\$.425 or three \$1.30 tickets
<b>Rural Express</b> .....	\$.525 or four \$1.30 tickets
<b>DayPass</b> .....	\$.750
<b>O-Train ticket</b> .....	\$.285

*(Bus tickets not accepted on the O-Train)*
