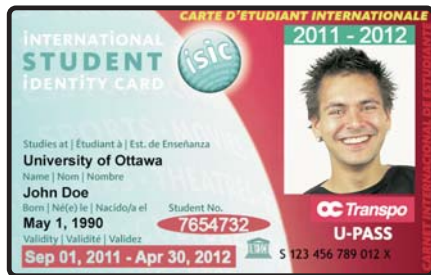
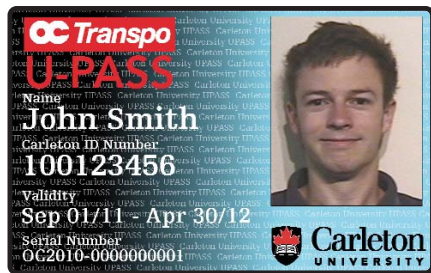




U-Pass

Universal Transit Pass

- **Pilot project for most full-time students at Carleton University and University of Ottawa**
- **Valid September 1, 2011 to April 30, 2012**
- **Unlimited travel, convenient, economical**



New U-Pass Starts September 1

This fall, full-time students at Carleton University and the University of Ottawa will enjoy the convenience of the new Universal transit pass. Students will have the freedom of getting around without worrying about exact fare, or buying bus tickets or the next month's pass.

The U-Pass pilot project is a partnership with the City of Ottawa, Carleton University and the University of Ottawa, as well as the students' unions at both universities. The program is administered by Carleton University Administration and by the students' unions at the University of Ottawa.

The U-Pass fee is \$290 for the fall and winter semesters, or \$145 for one semester.

Benefits of the U-Pass

- ✓ Significant savings compared to a regular monthly or semester pass — \$296 and \$210 respectively.
- ✓ Unlimited travel.
- ✓ Helps support a sustainable community.

What you need to know about using the U-Pass

- Valid September 1, 2011 to April 30, 2012.
- Valid as full fare on OC Transpo regular, express and rural express routes, and the O-Train.
- Valid on Para Transpo, although rural areas require a zone top-up.
- Valid on STO service with a top-up on express and interzone routes. If you board an STO route outside Gatineau's downtown core before 9 a.m., you must also have an Ontario Residency card. For more information, contact STO at 819-770-3242 or sto.ca.
- For full-time students only, including graduate students.

If you lose your U-Pass, call OC Transpo's Lost & Found at 613-563-4011. If your pass is not found, a replacement is available for a fee from the university for Carleton students, and through your students' union for University of Ottawa. See contact information below.

- Park & Ride
- Bike & Ride or Rack & Roll
- Connexion 400 service to Scotiabank Place for concerts and hockey games
- Late night service from downtown, including 24-hour service on Routes 95 seven days a week and on Route 97 Monday to Friday.

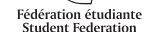
